



Sample Holding Statement – COVID-19

We are continuing to closely monitor the novel coronavirus (now named COVID-19) situation. As of February 26, County health officials report there are no confirmed cases of novel coronavirus in Placer County and the immediate health risk to the general public is low. However, further transmission of the disease is expected in the United States in the future, including here in Placer County. Visit placer.ca.gov/coronavirus for local updates.

We are working with the Placer County Office of Education and Placer County Public Health to establish protocols for schools and prepare for disruptions that could result from an outbreak. As a reminder, if your child is sick, please keep them home from school. You can always reduce your risk of respiratory illness by washing your hands; avoiding touching your eyes, nose and mouth; and avoiding close contact with people who are ill.
