## **District Meal Information**

**As of March 18, 2020**

### **AUBURN UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT**

The Auburn Union School District (AUSD) Child Nutrition Department will provide an opportunity for families to drive through and pick up meals for their children at all five AUSD school sites. Children must be present in order for meals to be provided.

All school sites will provide lunch for that day and breakfast for the following day. Meals will be served between 11:00 am and 1:00 pm Monday through Friday in the parking lot or bus lane at each school site. Please stay in your car and meals will be passed through based on the number of children in the vehicle.

This program is solely for the pick-up of meals and meals will not be consumed on-site. We are encouraging families to continue to be proactive in reducing the risk of COVID-19 by not congregating at the school site once meals have been distributed. We further encourage families to continue to wash hands often, sneeze or cough into a tissue and stay home if you are sick.

## **DRY CREEK JOINT ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT**

## **EUREKA UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT**

We will provide free meals to our students at all schools on Monday and Tuesday at the regularly scheduled times. Only schools that currently serve breakfast will be serving breakfast on Monday and Tuesday. There may be a need to consolidate the food service program starting on Wednesday. We will communicate any changes to you by Tuesday evening.

## TAHOE TRUCKEE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

Weekdays, Tuesday, March 17, through Friday, April 3, 2020, (unless a snow day is called) TTUSD will be providing meal services for pickup from 10:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m., Monday - Friday, unless a snow day is called. Lunch and breakfast for the next day will be provided to each child.

You can go to whichever location is most convenient for you - it does not have to be your child's school. But please note that the meals are available for pick up only. Our schools are closed for social distancing and there will be no eating onsite.

## WESTERN PLACER UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

WPUSD will continue to provide meals, breakfast and lunch, to all our students who are 18 years of age or younger during the closure period. Both breakfast and lunch meals (cold packs) can be picked up at Glen Edwards Middle School (Parking lot on the corner of L and 1st Street) based on this schedule:

- Our First Pick-Up will be Wednesday, March 18<sup>th</sup>. This pick up will provide lunch for 3/18, 3/19, 3/20 and breakfast for 3/19, 3/20, 3/23
- Additional Pick-Up dates will be Monday's, March 23rd and March 30th

Pick-Up Times: 11:00am-1:00pm

On pick-up days, each child will receive 5 days' worth of breakfast and lunch items. To limit interaction and proximity to other participants and therefore decrease the risk of COVID-19 exposure, food service staff will deliver these items to your vehicle upon arrival and there will be no onsite eating. Those who are 18 years of age or younger must be present to receive food.

Please remember some of the meals you will receive, contain items that must be refrigerated within two hours of receiving them. Leaving food out too long at room temperature can cause bacteria to grow and therefore will be unsafe to consume.
