ACKERMAN CHARTER SCHOOL DISTRICT

- Grab-n-go school meals are provided to Bowman students in the school cafeteria located at 13777 Bowman Road in Auburn daily from 7:30-8:30 a.m.

ALTA-DUTCH FLAT

- Grab-n-go school meals are provided in the school kitchen located at 34050 Alta Bonney Nook Rd Monday through Friday from 10 a.m. – 12 p.m.

AUBURN UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT

The Auburn Union School District (AUSD) Child Nutrition Department will provide an opportunity for families to drive through and pick up meals for their children at all three AUSD school sites.

- Children must be present in order for meals to be provided.
- Auburn Union School District will provide multiple days worth of meals.
- Meals will be served between 11:00 am and 1:00 pm on Tuesday and Thursday, in the parking lot or bus lane.
- Please stay in your car and meals will be passed through based on the number of children in the vehicle
- This program is solely for the pick-up of meals and meals will not be consumed on-site.
- We are encouraging families to continue to be proactive in reducing the risk of COVID-19 by not congregating at the school site once meals have been distributed.

Weekdays from 10 a.m. – 1 p.m., Tuesday, TTUSD will be providing meal services for pickup unless a snow day is called. Lunch and breakfast for the next day will be provided to each child. WESTERN PLACER UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

Pick up for Tuesdays each week.

Here are the details (please read all of the bullets):

- We will provide meals (breakfast and lunch) to all WPUSD area students who are 18 years of age or younger.
- Both breakfast and lunch meals (cold packs) can be picked up at four locations (McBean Park, Lincoln High School, Glen Edwards Middle School, Sheridan Elementary)
- Each student will receive 5 breakfasts and 5 lunches
- The distribution will begin at 11:00
- There is no charge for the food and you do not need to qualify as low income to receive the meals. All our students are welcome.
- An equal amount of food is at each location, pick the one most convenient to you
- Students must be present to receive food
- Please follow the directions of personnel on site so we can maintain social distancing. All personnel will be wearing masks and gloves based on the recent Placer County Health recommendation.
- There is no onsite eating allowed.
- Please remember some of the meals you will receive, contain items that must be refrigerated within two hours of receiving them. Leaving food out too long at room temperature can cause bacteria to grow and therefore will be unsafe to consume.
