

Placer County Office of Education Suspected Child Abuse and Neglect Reporting

Mandated Reporter Training

PC 11166

- All school employees are mandated reporters and required to report if someone is known or suspected to be a victim of child abuse, neglect or physical harm.

Suspected, Defined

- “Reasonable suspicion” does not require certainty that child abuse or neglect has occurred nor does it require a specific medical indication of child abuse or neglect; any “reasonable suspicion” is sufficient.



All School Employees

- All School Employees
 - Office Staff
 - Maintenance and Operations
 - Custodians
 - Teachers
 - Instructional Assistants
 - Administrators
 - Support Staff
 - ALL

When in Doubt...Report

- All employees must report any suspected child abuse or neglect
- You may discuss with another employee or supervisor before reporting, but someone else cannot report for you
- The other employee or supervisor now has knowledge of the suspected abuse or neglect and must now also report

Reporting Procedures

Immediately or as Soon as Practicably Possible...Within 36 Hours

- Step 1
 - Immediately get on the phone
 - Note name of person contacted, date, and time of contact
- Step 2
 - As soon as practicably possible get to the office, back to the class, or to a computer with internet access and file a written report with the appropriate county
