
At SELPA, we're here to support you throughout your child's IEP journey. We offer several types of assistance to help you better understand the process, address concerns, and work collaboratively with your school district.

Family Support

A SELPA Program Specialist will work with you and the school district to gather information, explain the IEP process, and help address any areas of concern or disagreement.

- Sharing guidance regarding Individualized Education Program (IEP) processes
- Supporting the work of the parent Community Advisory Committee (CAC)
- Hosting parent workshops and trainings
- Attending or facilitating IEP meetings to promote the resolution of concerns



CONFLICT RESOLUTION PROCESS

If you have concerns regarding your child's education, begin by contacting a staff member at the school site.

STEP 1

Contact your school site.

SCHOOL SITE LEVEL

- TEACHER
(EDUCATIONAL & CLASSROOM ISSUES)
- *SERVICE PROVIDER / SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST
(ASSESSMENT, BEHAVIOR &/OR PROGRAM/PLACEMENT ISSUES)
- SITE ADMINISTRATOR
(SCHOOL SAFETY AND PERSONNEL ISSUES)

*POSITIONS AND STAFFING VARY BETWEEN SCHOOL SITES.

IF UNRESOLVED, SEE STEP 2.

Find Your School District

STEP 2

Contact your school district.

DISTRICT LEVEL

- *PROGRAM SPECIALIST/COORDINATOR
(IF POSITION EXISTS WITHIN THE DISTRICT)
- ADDRESS PROGRAM CONCERNs
- *SPECIAL EDUCATION DIRECTOR
(EDUCATIONAL, PROGRAM, OR PLACEMENT ISSUES)
- *ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT OF EDUCATIONAL SERVICES OR STUDENT SUPPORT
(SITE, PERSONNEL OR EDUCATIONAL ISSUES)
- LEA SUPERINTENDENT
(SITE, PERSONNEL OR EDUCATIONAL ISSUES)

*POSITIONS/STAFFING VARIES BETWEEN SCHOOL DISTRICTS.
