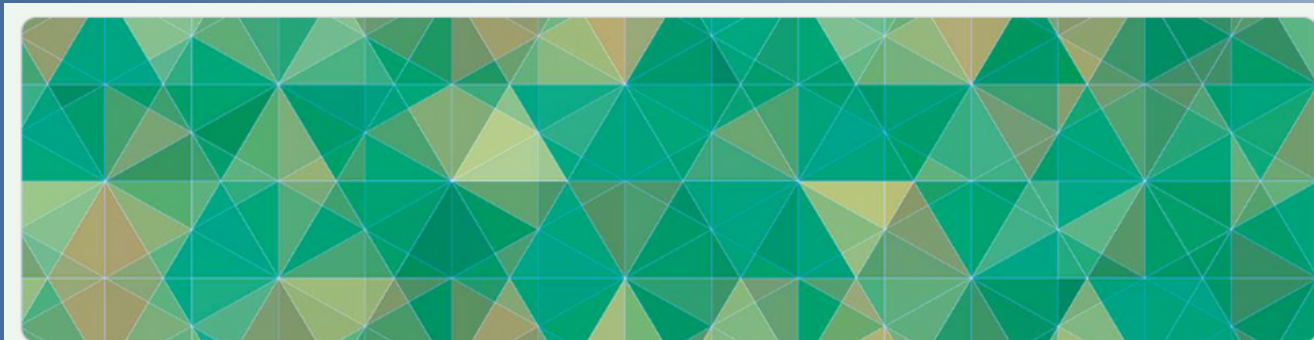
The Google Form covers the following prompts:
