### **Exciting Updates (This was also sent out last week)**

As we continue to see the number of COVID cases stabilize and begin to decrease in Placer county, our options begin to broaden as to how we operate our in-person instruction on campus.

As a result of these changes, we will be able to open up our Hybrid school to more students and for more instructional time per week.

So, after Spring Break **beginning on April 5<sup>th</sup> our Hybrid in person instruction will switch to three days a week, and the school day will extend to 12:30pm each day.**

We will continue to follow the guidelines as set by the department of health, which means students in grades Kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grade will continue to wear masks both inside and outside during the school day. We will have 4 feet physical distancing maintained in each classroom, and our practices in sanitizing surfaces will continue as we have been doing all year long.

### **Here's a summary of the changes:**

- On campus days for students will be Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday. School hours will change from 8:45am to 12:30pm.
- Pick up and drop off of student work will switch back to Mondays for all students.
- We will be combining both cohorts for the rest of the school year in each grade. (Meaning, all students will attend on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday).
- Distance learning will still be an option for families, however after April 5<sup>th</sup> our distance learning students must remain in distance learning for the rest of the current school year.
